New Rules for travelling to the UK

The UK's Electronic Travel Authorisation scheme (ETA) is set to roll out to more than 80 countries over the coming months.



The scheme requires visitors to the UK who are not required to obtain a visa for short stays to apply for an ETA in advance. The UK Home Office has announced an exemption to the scheme for transiting passengers.


Airport change

Claire joined Marine Travel in 2007 as an Accounts Assistant. Over the years she has had several roles within the accounts department and is now our Finance and Administration Director.




She is also responsible for finalizing the monthly and yearly management accounts for all our branches.
